REPORTS:

1. Parks and Recreation Report – Fred Poppe, Director Parks and Recreation

West Oaks Park renaming to Nungesser Park has been approved by the City Council, Nungesser Park renaming ceremony will take place on November 16, 10:00 am. Tim Nungesser will be on hand to speak for the family. This will be a family friendly event with the West Oaks Little League offering refreshments; all proceeds will benefit the little

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league.

Insurance will be paying to rebuild the playground that was burned down at Twin Lakes Park. Mr. Poppe asked for the board to consider supporting moving the park to Goode Park just down the street. This would increase available parking and access, while enhancing the overall safety of the kids that play at the park. Also this would effectively keep the kids away from traffic along Bianca Road and the retention pond that is right next to the old park location.

Planned improvements for Wake forest Park are in the bidding process to move forward.

The swimming pool is still closed at the Palm Bay Aquatic Center. A proposal for funding the repairs will be presented to the City Council later in November.

Improvements at the Greater Palm Bay Senior Center will be financed with assistance from a community development block grant. It will enhance the structure and make some much needed ADA improvements.

With the many events being held at the Fred Poppe Regional Park, there has been an increase in noise complaints from the neighborhoods surrounding the park.

Upcoming events for Palm Bay include the Veteran's Day Parade November 9th, Turkey Creek 5k November 16th and the Holiday Light Parade December 7th.

Mr. Poppe reported he was asked to speak at a meeting of the Youth Advisory Board; he covered stewardship and maintaining safe places to play.

Motion by Mr. Harris, seconded by Mr. Felix, to hold the December meeting at Parks and Recreation Conference Room, 1150 Degroodt Road, Palm Bay, Florida 32908, on December 3, 2019 at 7:00 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
