Slab Permit Submittal

Slabs for future structure may be permitted separately. If the structure to be placed is prebuilt and has Florida State product approval or manufactured building documents, these documents will serve as the foundation design parameters. For structures that do not meet the above, provide an Engineered foundation design.

Slabs not associated with a building or structure will be routed through Public Works (driveways) and Zoning (all other slabs not associated with a driveway)

- Structural Plans for future building or foundation plan
- Copy of certified boundary survey showing proposed property improvements must be an original signed and sealed document. (Zoning Department – 321-733-3042)
- Environmental Health Department (321-633-2100) approval stamp located on survey. This will be required to show distance from septic system. Located at: 2725 Judge Fran Jamieson Way Viera, 32940.
- Copy of the Recorded Notice of Commencement (when value is greater than \$5,000)

All documents are required to be electronically submitted through the IMS portal. The portal is an online application for the permit and all required information must be entered. When uploading documents, the "Requested Files" will only accept one (1) PDF, any additional files may be uploaded to the "Additional Uploads". Plans must be digitally signed and sealed by a Florida Licensed Architect/Engineer. To apply for a permit, you must register on the IMS portal. Approvals of other City of Palm Bay Departments must be obtained prior to the issuance of the permit.

Note: Additional documents may be required upon request by the Building Official.
