## 1. Fred Poppe, Recreation Department Director

• Operations – Additional funding approximately \$76K for monthly events (i.e., First Fridays, kids, teen events), and take over the Multi-Cultural event.

Mr. Graver asked will it be with the Chamber of Commerce or a separate event. Mr. Poppe stated it will be a city event. Also, asking for seed monies for the New Year's Eve Party.

- Capital Items Event pavilion at the Palm Bay Aquatic Center and building a bigger Captain's House. These monies will come out of impact fees.
- Vans Replacement of the current vans.

Mr. Olszewski asked about the type of vans. Mr. Poppe advised 15 passenger vans.

## 1. Renaming of Oakwood Park.

Motion by Mr. Olszewski to move New Business number 4 to number 1 seconded by Mr. Moore. Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Medina spoke about former City Councilman Pat Woodard and asked the committee for their support to rename Oakwood Park in memory of Pat Woodard.

Mr. Graver asked if the name will be Patrick Woodard Memorial Park. Mayor Medina stated its semantics.

Mr. Olszewski asked the years Councilman Woodard served. Mayor Medina advised nine years.

Motion by Mr. Olszewski to rename Oakwood Park to honor the late Councilman Patrick Woodard. Moore, seconded by Mr. Graver. Motion carried with members voting as follows:

Motion by Mr. Moore to cancel July meeting, seconded by Mrs., Russell. Motion carried unanimously members.

Mr. Poppe advised he plans on giving the committee a huge update on the budget and the projects (i.e., Disc golf, Dog Park).
