Information and Requirements (Please read carefully)

- Vendor fee for each 10'x10' event space:
 - Commercial Vendors: \$30
 - Non-Profit 501c3 & Palm Bay Chamber Members: 50% discount
- Vendor Registration deadline is **January 17. Payment in full must be made by this date.**
- Applications must be pre-approved for this event. The City of Palm Bay reserves the right to refuse any vendor application.
- Vendors must read and sign the attached waiver. Please fill out Vendor Registration Form completely.
- Vendors may be required to provide a certificate of liability insurance
- All fees for the event are non-refundable
- Vendor must provide their own table, tent (must be **weighted** down), chairs, extension cords, tent weights, etc.
- We recommend a full size cinder block per leg tied with a rope to the frame of the tent.
- Vendors cannot request a space location. Locations will be determined by Recreation staff.
- Vendor set-up time is between 8 AM and 10 AM. on Saturday or between 9 AM and 5 PM on Friday.
- If you set up Friday or leave anything to be picked up on Sunday or Monday, we cannot guarantee its safety.
- All vendors **MUST** be set up in their assigned location, with vehicles moved to the proper parking location, no later than **10 AM. No refunds will be issued if you arrive late. Support vehicles must be parked in the parking area.**
- Vendors must stay open until 5 PM and cannot breakdown early to clean up and remove your items. Unless Notified by event organizer.
- The vendor is responsible for leaving the vendor area in the condition that it was originally received, i.e. remove all debris such as boxes and trash.
